Involved are Oakland University, Oakland Community College (OCC) and Comerica Inc., which is the site's first occupant. Its 400,000-square-foot computer operations center is expected to open this summer on a 30-acre parcel.






ational and agricultural. Schostak said a few residences will be added as a buffer zone between the high tech operations and surrounding areas.

Auburn Hills planning commissioner B.J. Griffin said the community's land use plan calls for the area to be mainly prime residential and recreation.

SCHOSTAK SAID the city's master plan will have to be altered for the project to succeed.
"We're beging to freate a new totality of a master plan — create a special district unto itself," explained the Franklin realdent.

Also a consideration are tax abatements and other inducements to prospective tenants.
"Business incentives are very important to make as competitive," and Schostak. "To the extent our park can offer more incentives it makes us more attractive."

While those involved were pleased with the announcement, Frankel seemed especially proud. Since the early 1950s he's been buying land in the Rochester area, which he thought "would be the best place for people to move."
"I thought something would happen here, but I didn't realize the scope," said the developer, who credits OU's Champagne with serving as a "catalyst" for the endeavor.


