Each week the Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation Department will present a synopsis of upcoming activities in this column. For further information regarding our programs, contact our office at 474-6115.

**YOUTH SOCCER** — Registration is being accepted for children in grades Kindergarten through fifth grade for the spring soccer program at the Parks & Recreation office. Games will be played on Saturdays, with teams practicing once a week. A six-game schedule will be played. Registration fee is \$10 per participant and will be accepted to March 30.

**YOUTH SWIM LESSON REGISTRATION** — Registration for spring swim lessons will be taken on a first-come first-served basis until 4:30 p.m. Friday, April 6 at the Parks and Recreation office. The spring session will take place at North Farmington High School pool beginning Saturday, April 7, and run to June 2. Class schedule will consist of levels 1-5 from 10 a.m. to 10:50 a.m. and levels 1-2 and 6-10 from 11 a.m. to 11:50 a.m. The fee is \$13 per

participant.

**FITNASTICS** — Enjoy toning your body to formulated routines of exercise and dance. This activity will be instructed by Norine Yuskowatz, a popular fitness instructor from our area. The two-a-week sessions will meet on Mondays and Wednesdays beginning 6:30-7:30 p.m. April 2 at the Piemontese Club, 3650 Nine Mile. The fee for the eight-week session is \$35.

**AFTER-SCHOOL RECREATION** — The activity flyers will soon be distributed through the Farmington-area schools for planning your participation in the spring session of after-school recreation. Classes will include preschool ballet, gymnastics, ballet youth and adult, family classes, mime and clowning and more. Programs will be held at local elementary schools for this six-week program that begins the week of April 16.

**BOATING SAFETY CLINIC** — All persons 12 to 16 years of age who wish to operate a motorboat powered by six or more horsepower without adult su-

pervision must take a boating safety clinic and receive a boating safety certificate. Clinic will be held at Farmington Hills Library, 32737 12 Mile, April 10 and April 17, 6-9 p.m. (must attend both sessions). Preregistration is \$3 at the Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation office. Registration deadline is April 9. For further information, call 474-6115.

**YOUTH BAND** — The Parks & Recreation Department is sponsoring a youth concert band for children in grades 6, 7 and 8 who have had at least six months instrumental instruction. Classes will be scheduled for Wednesdays, beginning April 11 for 10 weeks. All participants must furnish their own instruments. Registration fee is \$10 per participant.

**ADAPTIVE RECREATION-SPORTS SPECTACULAR** — The Parks & Recreation Department is sponsoring an eight-week session where you will learn skill development in baseball, football, basketball and soccer for learning disabled people, ages 10 and over. Sessions will be held on Wednesdays, 6:30-8:30 p.m. at Oakland Community College from April 4 to May 23. Registration fee of \$12 should be completed at the Parks & Recreation office.


