Howard Fried Running For Baker's House Seat

FARMINGTON — Howard J. Fried of 6920 Drake Rd., Walled Lake, has announced his candidacy for the Democratic nomination for state representative from the 6th district.

The 46th district includes Farmington, West Bloomfield Township and a portion of Southfield including Lathrup Village.

The 46-year-old real estate broker and flight instructor is a graduate of Western Reserve University in Cleveland where he received an AB in English, a BS in psychology and an MA in sociology. He also has a juris doctor degree from Wayne State University.

Running as a Democrat in a heavily Republican district, Fried says he knows that the going will be all uphill.

"I am basing my campaign upon my availability and responsiveness to all the people of the district, and this alone should win for me in a district where the constituency has been unable to contact their representative," Fried commented.

The people of my district have not been really effectively represented for years," he added, "in that there has been no one to really listen to what they have to say."

Fried is a World War II veteran as a member of the Army Air Corps. He has taught four years on the college level and has been vice president and general manager of a radio station.

He is a real estate broker

and land dealer and has twice been appointed to the US Olympic squad as a fencer.

In his campaign literature, Fried says he favors liberalizing Michigan's abortion law, lowering the voting age, and Daylight Saving Time. He is opposed to state aid to private education.

In addition, the candidate says he favors leveling management of the local schools to local school boards and recognizes the need for the suburbs to support the central city.

Howard Fried, a Democrat running in the primary to face Rep. Raymond L. Baker (R-6th), has accomplished the feat.

On his way, Fried spotted a fat, male, domestic white rabbit on the roadside. Afraid the bunny might get hit by a car, the candidate rescued the animal and took him home for safekeeping until the owner can be found.

Oakland County Community College (OCC) is getting a second chance at accreditation, which was denied last year.

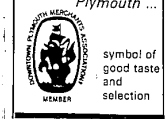
The failure to qualify led to its being a major campaign issue in recent trustee elections and in administration-faculty relations.
