THIS LESS expensive method of growing is quite satisfactory according to Fisher, who has a light arrangement.

Plants grown under lights, she said, must have the same number of hours of artificial light as plants growing in nature or in the greenhouse, depending on the time of year.

Plants are coded in such a way that in order to produce bloom, the grower must base the lightning schedule on the plant's individual needs.
