## Swedes raise the Maypole for Mid-Summer Fest

Swedes in the metro area carry on one of the most important holidays in Sweden when the longest day of the year is celebrated with Mid-Summer Fest.

Members of the Swedish Club carry on the tradition with the decorating and the raising of the Maypole that launches the celebration from 10 a.m. to dusk, Sunday, June 24.

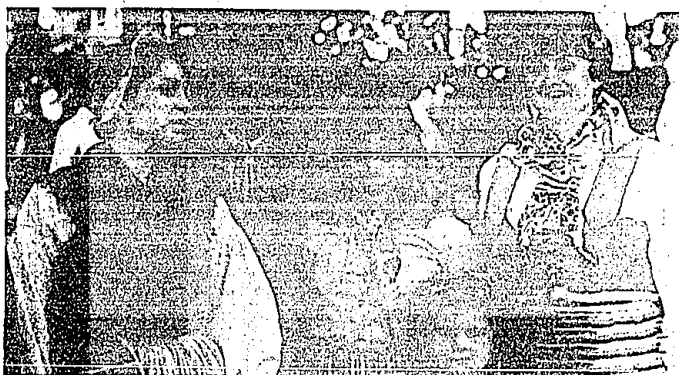
The Swedish Club building and grounds at Freedom and Ruth roads will all be utilized for the Mid-Summer Fest which includes ethnic entertainment, Scandinavian baked goods, foods, imports and handicrafts.

One of the highlights of the afternoon will be an outdoor concert given by members of Scandinavian Symphony, scheduled to begin at 2 p.m.

Guests who arrive early will be invited to take part in decorating and raising the Maypole, then be invited to join the ethnic singing and dancing around the pole.

The Scandia Women's Chorus will be on hand to entertain on the grounds, while inside the club house a Kaffe Stuga will offer coffee and baked goods to eat or to take home, as well as full course Swedish dinners.

There is no charge to the grounds.
