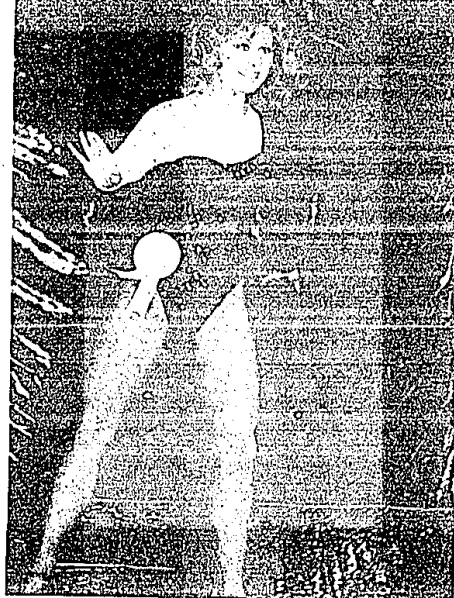




In the pageant

Rythmical therapy taught in conference

The Waldorf Institute is sponsoring the seventh annual American Rhythmic Therapy Conference from July 19 through August 12.

These conferences include a home-care course July 19-22 which teaches how to care for and help a patient who is at home, with special attention to illnesses in childhood and old age. The methods taught will include herbal compresses and wraps, as well as the use of baths and similar procedures.

The course is taught by Jannabeth van Salen, a nurse from Holland with more than 20 years of experience in hospital and private practice. She has

conducted similar courses in the U.S. and Europe.

In addition there will be both an introductory (July 22-23) and an intermediate-advanced (July 29 to Aug. 12) course of rhythmic therapy.

Rhythmic therapy, which is a first cousin to rhythmic massage, is an art whereby the therapist, or parent or friend, can use his or her hands to help strengthen the healing forces of the patient.

The rhythmic therapy conferences are taught by a group of therapists from all over the U.S., all of whom have trained in Europe. In addition, the

The conferences are open to all who are interested in learning a comprehensive approach to care and therapy. The work is both practical with supervised sessions of hands-on work and theoretical with lectures and seminars.

The content is derived from the work of Dr. Rudolf Steiner, whose work has given rise to new endeavors in many fields, including education, special education, agriculture, art, medicine, architecture and philosophy.
