

Prepare special friends for annual pet show

For the 17th consecutive year, the staff at the Plaza Veterinary Hospital and Pets 'N' Particulars will present a children's pet show during the festival. This year the show will be held as part of the Kids Day program at 1 p.m. Tuesday, July 17, on the stage of the Showmobile at the Farmington City Park, Shawwassee and Power roads.

Trophies will be awarded to the first, second and third place winners in each category.

Loan association elects new trustee

Allen is also a trustee of the Arnold Home, Children's Hospital of Michigan, and the Michigan Cancer Foundation.

A native of Monroe, Mich., Allen graduated from the University of Michigan with a bachelor of arts and a master of business administration degree in finance.
