"Magnificent Seven" is the Americanization of Akira Kurosawa's classic "Seven Samurai" (1954), the Japanese film about warriors who come to the aid of a town in 16th-century feudal Ja-

pan. The American film, set in a Western frontier town, stars Yul Brynner, Steve McQueen, Charles Bronson, Ell Wallach, James Coburn, Robert Vaugha and Horst Buchholz, and is both better and worse than its predecessor. It's not as good in tone or atmosphere but it's nearly as good in the action sequences, and better because it's more than an hour shorter than the overly long classic. It's also a forerunner to the spaghetti westerns popularitieed by Clint Eastwood. The moving musical score is by Elmer Bermstein.


