

### Candidates Warned On Road Signs

The State Highway Commission is asking candidates for public office to refrain from posting their advertising signs within the right-of-way of state highways.

Unofficial signs posted along busy highways detract and confuse motorists, constituting a driving hazard. Highway Dept. maintenance employees have standing instructions to remove all such signs from state highway rights-of-way and bridges, the commission said.

Election years usually bring a flurry of political signs along state highways, although rapid removal of such signs usually discourages further placements.

# Stenger Leaves Schoolcraft

Robert A. Stenger, academic dean of Schoolcraft Community College, is leaving to become president of Kirtland Community College in Rosecommon.

His release here will be considered by Schoolcraft trustees tonight (Wednesday). He is scheduled to begin duties as head of the 500-student Kirtland campus Aug. 1.

Stenger's departure will close a 10-year association with Plymouth, where he began his career as an English teacher and drama coach at Plymouth High. He joined the five-community Schoolcraft Community College in 1961, an English instructor, and came dean in 1966.

He has been active in the Plymouth Assembly of Equal Opportunity, the Plymouth area Boy Scouts and is currently master of a Northville cub pack. He and his wife, Beverly, and their five children live in Northville.

He is a member of a number of professional associations and is currently in the second year of a three-year appointment to the Commission on Instruction for the American Association of Junior Colleges.

Stenger's productions of musicals with high school talent will long be remembered in Plymouth. He also gained

some renown in his early years as an athlete, especially for record-setting times in the half-mile run and on the football field.

HIS NON-ACADEMIC experience has ranged from production and advertising with his hometown newspaper in Pennsylvania; as a glass blower's helper and designer, his father's trade; the steel industry, and with the U.S. Army security agency.

He has had two articles printed in leading scholastic publications: "Rocket to the Moon or Higher," a guide to creative thinking, was published in the Michigan English Teacher in 1964; "Pronouns or Prepositions," was published in the English Journal in 1960.

Stenger gave two reports at

the 1969 conference of the Association of Junior Colleges.

He believes a post high school education "is no longer a luxury; it is a necessary and that a comprehensive community college can help a student determine the choices for which his natural gifts and interests "best suit him" and can speed him towards successful attainment of goals.
