Consideration of Cluster Housing Site Plan No. 80-5-84 in Section 34 in RA-3 zone was adjourned until meeting of September 17, 1984.

Consideration of Cluster Housing Site Plan No. 81-5-84 in Section 22 in RA-1 zone was adjourned until meeting of September 17, 1984.

Economic Development Corporation Resolution No. 3 was adopted setting date for public hearing for Meyer, Place and Hinds, Ltd. Project located on south side of Middlebelt Road, east of Haggerty Road, on September 10, 1984.

Council adopted Economic Development Corporation Resolutions No. 1, No. 2 and No. 3 for Orchard Place Development Project, located on Orchard Lake Road, south of Tully Hall, setting public hearing date on September 10, 1984 and naming Harlem Morris and Donald Meade as additional directors for the project.

Economic Development Corporation Resolution No. 3 was adopted setting date for public hearing for H & J Industrial Center Project, located at 24618-24669 Halsted Road, between Grand River and Eleven Mile Road, on September 10, 1984.

Economic Development Corporation Resolution No. 3 was adopted setting date for public hearing for Greater Detroit Otologic Group, located on west side of Middlebelt, south of Twelve Mile Road, on September 10, 1984.

Council adopted resolution approving Charter Amendment proposal to appear on November 6, 1984 ballot for 1.5 mill, for 20 years to expire June 30, 2005.

Council agreed to a joint meeting with the Planning Commission for August 30, 1984 to review proposed revision in Zoning Ordinance.

Council adopted a policy for procedure for adding unpublished items to City Council Agenda.

Michigan Municipal League Convention expenses were approved by Council. Jan Dolan was appointed as Delegate to the Michigan Municipal League Convention to replace Mayor Williams and Joan Dudley was appointed as alternate.

Council accepted Annual Fire Department Report for 1983.

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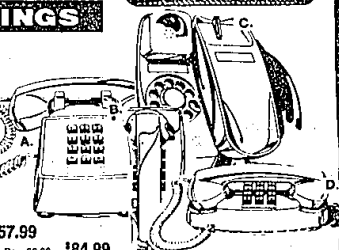
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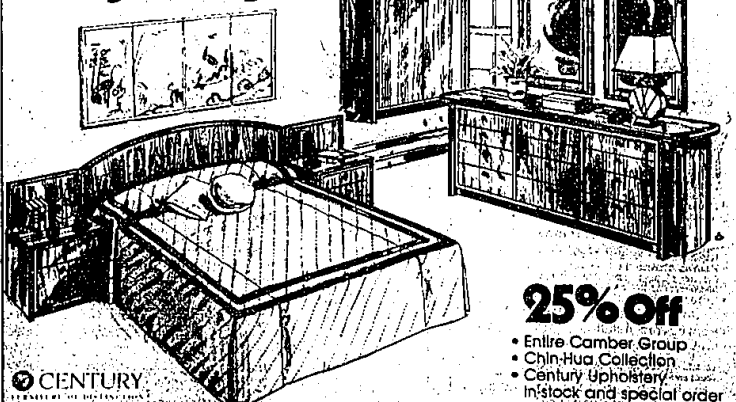
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
