Residential burglaries on decrease

Residential burgiaries in Farmington have decreased 24 percent for the first six months of 1984 as compared to the same time period in 1983, according to a police operations report.

The report indicates the number of crimes reported for the first six months of 1984 as compared to the same time period last year. The study was submitted to the Farmington City

Council by G. Robert Selfert, the city's director of public safety.

"It is part-year data, and significant changes can occur at any time," Slefert cautioned when asked about the report. The reports are done to Inform the council and the public "what is going on" in the community, safe Slefert.

"A more detailed report is given at the whole year when we can look at the whole year and not just a part of it, as we do here," Selfert explained.


