
Virtually self-taught in photography, he was a member of the Miniature Camera Club of Detroit which, in the 1940s, changed its name to the Photo-graphic Guild of Detroit.

THE GROUP included other young photographers like (in Todd Webb and Arthur Siegel, who, like Caliahan, later achieved national reputations. Through the club several major figures were brought to Detroit — among them, An asel Adams, who influenced Caliahan to give up commercial work for fine art photography. experience processing itim in the photo labs of General Motoris (1944-44) may account for his technical mastery of the medium.

Caliahan was appointed head of the department at Illinois, a position he beld for 10 years.

In 1956 he was the only phtographer to receive a Graham Foundation Award for Advanced Studies in Fine Arts and spent a year photography in Europe, with Aix-en-Provence, France, as his base, in 1861 he became Associate Professor of Photography at the Rhode Island School of Design.
