

U-M To Host 'Aging' Session

ANN ARBOR The University of Michigan will host a national Conference on Aging, expected to draw more than 500 professional policy makers and senior citizens, from Aug. 12 to 14. It will be the 23rd annual meeting to be held here.

This year's conference program emphasizes the "urgent need to evaluate the position of older people in contemporary American society and to establish guidelines for achieving a meaningful existence for all older Americans."

The conference theme is "Roles for older People. Prospects for the 70s." Specific discussion topics include the senior citizen's social roles, the expectations of the elderly, and community programs ranging from income maintenance to creative activity.

AN ADDRESS BY John Martin, U.S. commissioner on Aging, and a discussion session will focus on preparation for the next White House conference on Aging which is scheduled for December, 1971. Several preliminary community and state meetings for the White House conference are scheduled during the next year.

The final day of the Aging

Conference will be devoted to a celebration of the 50th anniversary of the Social Security Act, signed by President Franklin D. Roosevelt.

A luncheon will honor distinguished leaders in the Social Security program, including many of those involved in the early history of the act. All former commissioners of social security have been invited to attend the luncheon. Robert

Bald, the present commissioner, will discuss the future of Social Security.

Other major speakers during the three-day conference will include: Robert Butler, M.D., of George Washington University; Theodore Ernst, professor of social welfare at the University of New York at Buffalo; David Gil, professor of social policy at Brandeis University; and Clark Tibbitts.
