Funny Thing Befalls Comedy

A funny thing happened on the way to the Forum on its way to the Will-O-Way play playhouse in Bloomfield Hills.

The Broadway play relied heavily on Billy Daniels' far punch and the belly of Zero Mostel for laughs in a kind of overblown Minsky-style burlesque in toga.

But a cast of thousands, on the stage at Will-O-Way in a glossy, Broadway-type production points out the difficulty of recruiting a cast of thousands to a local stage without leaving the gloss patchy, at best.

ROBERT ROGEZ turned in a commendable though erratic performance as the slave Pseudolus, a Sgt. Bulko with a bulge that had the audience wincing in sympathy instead of laughing.

Earl Erickson skulks through a shifty role as Lycus, keeper of the "house," and William Jones, as Hysterium gets a lot of laughs as the effeminate slave master, but a few in the wrong places.

The Will-O-Way Repertory

Company, in attempting to put a big show in the small theatre took a chance on stretching the ability of a small company to get all the "bits" down pat.

The elements of a big-bawdy, comedy-musical are there. The show runs for three more weeks at Will-O-Way and by that time they may have it together.

Lee Acheson, who plays Seneca's wife, Domitia is good and shrewish, but somehow lacks the needling realism that would make the part really funny.

Kevin Hackett, as the lustful son, and Diane Magaw as the lost-daughter-slave play a duo of innocents.
