The 23rd Annual Writer's Conference at Oakland University, featuring award-winning mystery writer, Elmore 'Dutch' Leonard as keynote speaker is scheduled for Oct. 26-27.

Open to the public, it provides a two-day opportunity for aspiring, novice,

In addition to Leonard, nationally known children's book author Nancy Willard, Detroit poet laureate Dudley Randall and author Charles Baxter, will share their ideas on writing.

Among guests slated to head workshops or lab sessions are New York agents Philippa Brophy from Sterling Lord Agency and Diane Cleaver, who heads her own literary agency; popular author Gay Courter of Florida; Zondervan editor Cheryl Forbes, religious writing; novelist Robert C. Wilson, author of the bestseller "leedire," and romance writer Julia Grice, who will be the Friday evening speaker.

WJR Radio's Hal Youngblood, also known for his creative work in theater, will head a workshop on playwriting. Iris Sanderson Jones and Mickey Jones will cover writing travel stories including photography required and Margo LaGattutta will lead a workshop on enhancing creativity using the "right brain" technique, a concept successfully being used by today's authors.

Conference sessions on Oct. 26 will provide an arena for writers who wish to have their work critiqued by profes-

sionals in h-depth lab sessions. Manuscripts alredy submitted, will be discussed durilg 12 concurrent sessions. The sessions include: general fiction, beginning fittion, children's fiction, young adult ketion, articles, reviews and essays, potry, religion and a general category.

Sessions scheduled for 9 a.m. Oct. 27 will start with 430 a.m. registration. Leonard will speak after a noon lunch-eon. He is the revent recipient of the prestigious Mystery Writer of America award.

In his talk, "The Writer's Voice," Leonard will emphasize the impor-tance of developing cie's own style and discuss dealing with publishers, agents and those in the film industry.
