## Good movie hosts are hard to find

The best movies on 1V are those shown uncut and without interruption—that's for sure. Canada's CBET Ch. 9 comes closest, airing most movies in their entirety and with a minimum of commercial interference. The movies seldom are new or even recent, but purists take heart knowing they are at least intact. Occasionally public TV. (Ch. 56, opens its vaults and runs a movie marathon, giving air time to classic films that remain stashed away 11½ months out of the year. These broadcasts are "commercial-free," too, although countless interruptions for pledge breaks more than compensate for the lack of traditional sponsors.

There can be no disagreement that there's no substitute short of cable for movies-on-TV fans who want their motion pictures screened in totality. Yet there's another form of movie entertainment—the antithesis of un-cut, uninterrupted movies—that dis-appearing from the scene. It is an art form nonetheless, and, in a way, it's a shame that it's becoming a thing of the nast. That's the TV movie host.

When Kennedy was on the mark, he augmented his movie presentations with fascinating tidblis of gossip and trivia often culled firsthand from encounters with producers, directors and stars furing Kennedy's own Hollywood days and night.
