Halloween Howl II — The Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation Department, in cooperation with the Farmington Community Library, Farmington YMCA and the Farmington Community Center will be sponsoring "Halloween Extravaganza" on Wednesday, Oct. 31, 5:30-7:30 p.m. This event is an alternative to "trick or treating" and there will be games, costume contests, various special activities and much more. Flyers will be distributed soon through your local school.

Prenatal and postpartum exercise class — Join in to assist your body for

your "Birthing Day" with exercises that specifically focus on strengthening and toning muscles. Classes will be Tuesdays from Oct. 30 to Dec. 4, 7-8 p.m. Beat the "postpartum blues" and recover your pre-pregnant figure by stretching, strengthening and toning muscles most affected by your recent pregnancy. Classes should be taken 4-6 weeks after the birth of your child and will begin Oct. 30 and run to Dec. 4, 8-9 p.m. on Tuesdays. Babies welcome. Each participant must have a physician's written recommendation. Class fee is \$25 for each session.

CPR — This American Red Cross course is a nine-hour comprehensive class and refresher course. The session will run Thursday, Nov. 8, Tuesday, Nov. 13 and Thursday, Nov. 15. Classes will be at O.E. Dunkel Middle School 7-

9 p.m. The class fee is \$5 and includes books and handouts. Registration is required.

Ice skating lessons — Learn to skate or improve your technique. Our lessons include the beginner through the advanced. Classes meet for 30 minutes weekly, for six weeks. The second session will begin during the week of Nov. 5. Classes are scheduled at 3:30 p.m. for children and 7:30 and 8 p.m. for adults. All lessons will be at the Beech Woods Arena and the class fee is \$25.

Senior adults — flu shots — The Oakland County Health Department will be offering flu shots at the Senior Adult Center on Tuesday, Oct. 30 at 10 a.m. to noon. This year's vaccine protection will be against three viral strains: A/Chile, A/Philippines and B/USSR. There is a charge of \$2 per shot; however, no one will be turned away from this opportunity.

Senior Adult — Halloween party/10th anniversary — On Friday, Nov. 2, the 10th year of the Senior Adult Program along with our ninth annual Halloween Party will be celebrated at the Senior Adult Center. We will be inviting former staff members, interns, volunteers and all of you that help make our program the special one that it is. Even if you don't feel like dressing up in a Halloween costume, please come and join the dancing, singing, music, old and new friends and see the surprises we have planned. There is no fee.

Youth basketball registration — Registration is being accepted for the boys and girls youth basketball program. All 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th graders are eligible to take part. Teams will be formed by neighborhood location and grades. The instructional clinics will begin in December, with league games starting Saturday, Jan. 5. Registration fee is \$14.

Leaf burning is prohibited

Farmington Hills fire officials are reminding residents that burning of leaves, trash and tree trimmings is prohibited by city ordinance.

Open burning is a misdemeanor with a penalty of a \$100 fine and/or 90 days in jail, said Lt. Richard Marinucci.

Burning material outside is prohibited because of the potential hazards, Marinucci said.

"Fortunately we haven't had any major fires. We have had minor fires though," he said.

FIRE OFFICIALS do not patrol neighborhoods for open burning. But they do respond when a resident reports a neighbor for burning material outside.

"It ticks up a pretty big bill for the city in personnel costs," Marinucci said, adding fire fighters are paid \$9.80 an hour to be called to a neighborhood to stop open burning.

The ordinance also prohibits residents from burning material in drums. The city also does not issue permits to burn.
