# School board seeks to plug energy leaks

The Waller Lake Board of Education is considering an "energy audit" of all school-owned buildings and facilities to identify ways to save energy and heating and air conditioning.

Donahue explained that Public Act 430, which requires a school district to conduct an energy audit of its school buildings, and that the audit must be completed by the end of the fiscal year.

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audit should supervise all energy projects. Donahue said. In addition, the first audit report is to monitor energy consumption in each building for 12 months after construction ends to determine energy savings.

If the annual energy savings are not sufficient to pay off the cost of the district that would have to use operating funds to make up any shortfalls.

Donahue suggested the district begin making notes in the spring. The district then would have two years to complete work on energy conservation projects. The school board took no action on Donahue's proposal. It will be considered at tonight's regular board meeting.

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
