

Livonia And Westland Get State Bond Funds

Livonia and Westland will share in \$2.5 million of \$5.7 million being released by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources as the first allocations under the \$100 million

recreation bond money approved by the voters in 1968. Allen Park, Dearborn, Northville and Detroit will share in the same funds released to region VII (Wayne County) projects. The other six regions will receive the balance of the first allocations.

MICHIGAN'S Department of Natural Resources is ready, willing, and able to make its first release of recreation bond money, totaling some \$5.7 million, for 59 local projects earlier approved to receive the funds.

The \$5.7 million, appropriated by the Legislature in early July, will be distributed as reimbursements to cover the state's share of the projects' costs.

These funds will be parceled out as soon as each recreation project is completed and local units of government bill the DNR for their previously approved developments or land purchases.

To date, the DNR has signed agreements with local units of government, authorizing 28 of

the 59 projects to get under way.

A number of those projects drawing the Department's go-ahead are expected to be completed shortly, setting the stage for local leaders to apply for cost reimbursements they have been assured.

OF THE FIRST BOND revenues earmarked for local projects, about \$4.8 million will go for recreation development work, with the balance of \$900,000 to underwrite acquisition of lands for leisure-time needs.

These local grants will be made among 6 of 7 regions into which Michigan has been divided by law to provide equitable funding of recreation bond monies for grassroots projects throughout the state.

Project by billed project, the \$7.1 million in those funds will be routed as follows:

- L'Anse, Ironwood, and Hancock areas within Region I (Upper Peninsula) — \$67,730.
- Iosco and Oscoda counties within Region III — \$45,856.
- Grand Rapids, Grand Haven, Adrian, Wyoming, and Kent County within Region IV — \$294,907.
- Flint, Genesee County, Saginaw, Pontiac, and Bridgeport Township within Region V — \$1,152,509.
- St. Clair Shores, Royal Oak, Ferndale, East Detroit, Warren, and Pontiac within Region VI — \$1,050,964.
- Detroit, Allen Park, Livonia, Dearborn, Westland, and Northville within Region VII — \$2,476,576.

NEIGHBORHOOD PARKS and playfields account for a large number of the projects for which the initial bond money will be spent. Part of the funds will also be used to develop a municipal beach, swimming pools, ice rinks, and recreation centers.

The entire \$5.7 million cover only the first series of local requests screened by the Department of Natural Resources and then cleared through the Legislature for funding. Out of the total \$100 million recreation bond program, \$30 million is earmarked for local projects.

In the first go-around of screening last October, no qualified local recreation projects were established for Region II. That region covers Emmet, Charlevoix, Antrim, Leelanau, Benzie, Grand Traverse, Kalkaska, Manistee, Wexford, Missaukee, Mason, Lake, Oshtemo, Oceana, Newago, and Mecosta counties.

Under the second and third series of review, 133 projects calling for \$6 million in bond funds were approved by the DNR in January and May and cleared through the State Legislature.

It is expected that those latest projects, located in all 7 regions previously mentioned, will be funded with monies from the next recreation bond sale. Tentative plans are to hold that sale this fall.
