Project HERS starts Feb. 5

Project HERS (Homemaker's Employment Re-Entry System), a program offered by Women's Resource Center of Schoolcraft College for displaced homemakers, offers career planning and assertiveness training. The program is designed to make entry or re-entry into the work force not only possible, but less traumatic for mature women. Displaced homemakers are people who have worked in the home most of their lives, and lost their source of income due to death, disability, desertion, divorce or separation

from the person on whom they were dependent. Financial aid is available to cover course costs for those who are displaced homemakers, part-time homemaker-wage earners or single heads of a household who lack adequate job skills as well as recent, skilled, full-time work experience. There are a lot of ways to describe the music of the Max Davey Singers. Sometimes it's hushed as in the matting version of "The Way We Were."
