# Wolverine Gamble Pays Off With Fastest Mile.

Statistics tell the story of the success of Wolverine Raceway's gamble that patrons would like the change from racing over a half-mile to the big mile track.

After 20 years of programs on the twice around oval, President Frederick Van Lennep and associates in the Wolverine official family decided to change to the wider, longer backstretch and homestretch of the mile track.

They realized that it would be a tremendous gamble since few of the customers in the metropolitan Detroit area had ever seen a harness race on anything but the half-mile strip.

Thus there were quite a few qualms on opening night.

THE FANS also were quickly erased when a crowd of 9,342 poured through the turnstiles and wagered \$573,066, a record for a Wednesday night opening.

But it was the Friday and Saturday weekend that clearly showed how well the big mile was accepted...the figures proved that bettors not only liked the change, they loved it.

Saturday's attendance of 12,166 was the largest ever for a Saturday and the second highest in Wolverine's 21 years. And the crowd was in a wagering mood since it sent \$718,858 through the machines for the most ever handled.

The previous high was the \$714,058 of Saturday, April 13, 1968.

stable of Greenville, O., captured the featured Invitational Pace with a stunning rally in the stretch to win by a length in 2:00.1.

Other all-time highs set during the course of the evening included the largest attendance for two nights -- 10,255 on Friday and 12,166 on Saturday for a total of \$718,858, an average of \$636 for the first four nights of the meeting.

Then the betting for the weekend was another record with a total of \$1,367,778, shattering the previous high of \$1,280,012 set on May 23 and 24 in 1969.

THE PRESENTATION of the historic Motor City Pace Friday brought out some of the finest racing ever seen in the Detroit area. It found Waycount Hanover, a three-year-old Sampson direct colt owned by C. Lyons of Aurora, O., and E. Casagione of Hudson, O., and driven by Gerry Bookmeier, charging out of the seventh spot to win the second of two eliminations in 2:01 and then coming back in the 10-horse final to make every post a winning one for a half-length triumph in 2:03.3.

That was a record for the big mile track. Just to add a bit of spice to the already over-loaded menu, Bookmeier registered four triumphs during the evening to become the first reinsman to accomplish that feat at the young meeting.

And these records went by the boards during the course of the night. The crowd of 10,255 was the third largest for a Friday. The mutual handle of \$648,920 was the most ever for a Friday and the fourth highest in Wolverine annals.

Wander past any of the area's high schools these days -- whether it's Southfield Lathrup or John Glenn in Westland or in between -- and you're apt to see a crowd on the football field.

If you pause long enough to investigate you'll find that what's going on is no rock session, no fun carnival or anything like that.

You'll discover that the crowd is made up of some serious young men -- all in their teens -- and all getting ready for the high school football season ahead.

Under the state rules, no school can begin OFFICIAL practice until Aug. 24, which is now less than two weeks away.

But, there's nothing against coaches conducting conditioning programs for their charges...and that's what just about every Observersland coach is doing at the moment.

The times of the sessions vary. Some coaches bring the boys together in the early morning. Others have them gather in the early evening.

Others call them out twice a day...a few two or three times a week.

The boys don't see a football. They wear no football gear of any kind.

THERE ARE SOME grumblers in the crowd. It's not easy to engage in calisthenics day after day...to work on leg and arm-strengthening...to try and chop down a few (or several) extra pounds.

Besides, it takes you away from a chance to go swimming or fiddle around with the other kids during the closing weeks of summer vacation.

But, in the main, the majority of the crowd is dedicated...is hard working...is serious.

"We tell them how important it is to be in shape for the start of practice," says Bob Atkins, Redford Union High head coach.

"Most of the kids realize that if they're going to play they have to be in physical condition. Since most of the boys really want to play...well, they work at making sure they'll be ready."

To the coach it's just as important that his charges come to the first regular practice fit and set to go.

Football has to be the toughest sport of all when it comes to moulting together a team.

You appreciate the complexity of the job when you drop out to Cranbrook and watch the Lions in session under Joe Schmidt.

WHILE IT'S TRUE that Schmidt and his college counter-parts have more assistants than the head man of a high school team, the actual job remains the same.

Stand out there in the serenity of the Cranbrook campus and note how the Lions go at it.

In the middle of the field, there's Schmidt himself overseeing a couple of punters and place-kicker Errol Mann.

Down at the other end, the defensive squad is operating; Jim David is in charge with Jim Martin aiding.

The linemen work on one side, the defensive backs on the other.

Along the sideline, you'll find the interior offensive linemen with their coach, Chuck Knox.

John North takes another group off to the side. They're the receivers...the Charlie Sanders, Earl McCullochs, etc.

Bill McPeak, who heads the offensive strategy, is close by. He had the quarterbacks (Bill Munson, Gary Landry, etc.)

The specialists are all at work at what they do best and what they must do in a game. The head coach wanders from one group to another.

IT'S NOT UNTIL the practice is well along that Schmidt brings everybody together.

Now interior offensive linemen are working with the receivers, the running backs and the quarterbacks.

All the defensivemen are lined up together to function as a unit.

Pretty soon, there's an inter-team scrimmage...the offensive against the defensive...to get the feel of things as Coach Schmidt says.

But by and large, the players drill in their small groups. It's the best way for them to accomplish what is expected of them.

Of course, you'll never see this when it's game time...when the Lions or any other team has swung into action against the real enemy.

By now there's team work, there's cohesion...there's what everybody agrees is so important: "team spirit."

To achieve it, though, in football is not easy.

You start with the individual...you develop individual specialists...then the group specialists...and finally you put them all together and, hopefully, the result is a champion.

Ten days from now, every high school football coach in Michigan will be trying to do the same thing.
