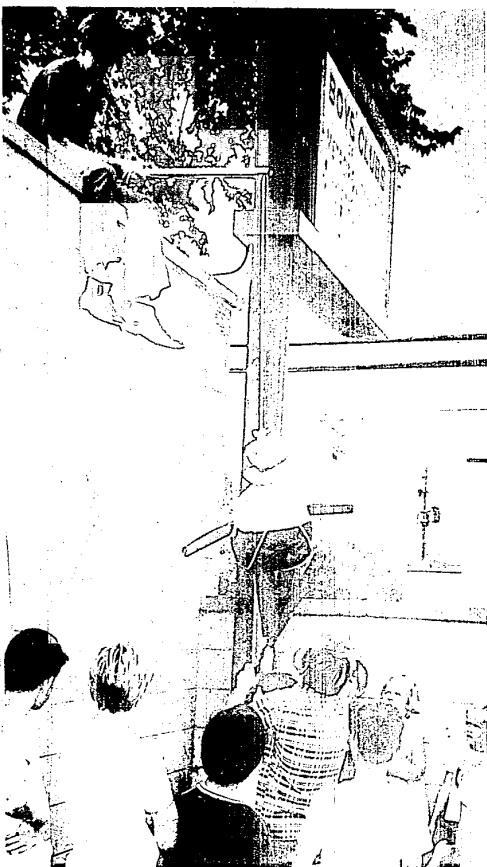


Fun At Redford Boys Club Carnival

Burroughs Computer In England

The project, sponsored by the British Government, will involve the consolidation of those communities to form the New City of Milton Keynes in a 22,000-acre midway between London and Birmingham.

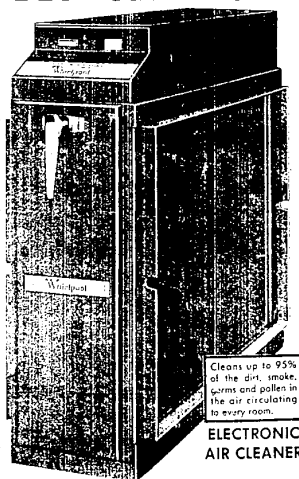
