There are trips to the Zoo, Cranbrook, the Belle Isle Aquarium and other places of interest.

Music is an important part of each day. Director Mrs. David Holtzman - the children call her Auntie Sarah - provides lively dances, rhythm bands, and impromptu song fests.

Friendly staff members, one for every eight to 10 children, have ample time to listen and talk with the children as individuals.

Learning to get along with others is one of the goals.

For these youngsters who are ready to absorb it, there is an excellent reading -- readiness and kindergarten program available.

There is freedom within limits and plenty of space for noise and action -- both indoors and out. When the outside playground equipment cannot be used, there is an indoor slide and sandbox, plus those standards such as dolls to cuddle, boats to rock, a fair to make things interesting, housekeeping corners and a full sized kitchen where the "real" nourishing lunches are prepared.

County Distributes Sesqui-Centennial Coin

Oakland County Treasurer C. Hugh Dohany has received the final shipment of the Sesqui-Centennial commemorative coins and delivered them to banks and savings and loan offices throughout the county for final sales.

A total of 5,000 silver coins numbered and in a plastic case were minted. They sell for \$10. A total of 1,000 commemorative coin sets were minted

which consists of one bronze and one silver, numbered identically and placed in a green leather case with a white satin background with the Oakland County Seal in gold stamped on the satin. These sell for \$12.50.

SINCE THERE are a limited number of coins available, they will not only be a collector's item in years to come.

The design of the coin is by the internationally known sculptor, Marshall Fredericks, who volunteered his talent and skill to assist our county in this celebration.

THE REVERSE SIDE of the coin carries the inscription "Sesqui-Centennial" and the years "1820-1970".

Chief Pontiac is featured carrying a pipe of peace,

peace being the treasured dream of all men since time immemorial. Directly behind Chief Pontiac's head is a full moon, depicting the passing of time or the end of an era.

The design on the obverse side of the coin is a replica of the seal of our great county, featuring a white oak tree with a sunburst behind the tree. Oakland County derived its name from the great oak tree.

forests that the first settlers observed here before 1820. The white oak tree is known as the symbol of strength, durability and grandeur.

The coin depicts the passing of one era that belonged to and passed with the Red Man and the beginning of our own history as symbolized by the sunburst behind the oak tree.
