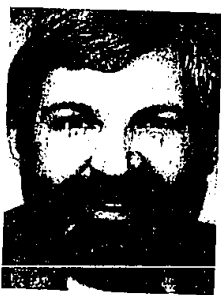

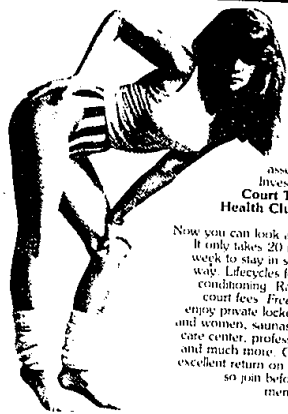
Registration for the spring term for new and returning students will be held from March 4 through March 22 and April 1 through April 30.

GRIEF AND GUILT

It is normal and healthy for people to grieve after the loss of a loved one. It has been said, in fact, that grief and love are two sides of the same coin. The more one cares about another, the more deeply the loss will be felt.

Feelings of guilt, on the other hand, are more likely to be unhealthy, though they are not at all uncommon. The closer the human relationship, the more chance there is for guilt to be at least part of the response. A child may have resisted the authority of a parent, even wished the parent dead. A parent may be haunted by thoughts of having failed to protect the child from illness or accident. A sibling may feel guilty simply for being alive.

There is no easy answer. Many people who are troubled by overwhelming feelings of guilt find it useful to work those out with a clergyman or counselor.
