"I WAS really glad everyone came," Gilles said. "I really wanted to see everyone and I'm glad they wanted to see But, I was really, really nervous. I'm not blaming the loss on that. I'm blaming me, mentally, Even after I got over being nervous, I didn't pull it out."

Wisconsin has played 10 of the na-tion's top 20 teams already this season. Gilles, after beating Michigan State's Trish Bandenbrink, 8-0, 6-4, Saturday and losing to Relehert Sunday, is 12-8 in singles. Wisconsin is 11-10.

FERGUSON ISN'T too concerned about Gilles' ability in singles.
"She'll be all-Big 10, 1m 80 percent sure of that. And she should go to nationals. The top four singles players from the region quality for nationals, and Chris is ranked No. 3 right now,"

But there are other areas, Ferguson said, in which Gilles needs plenty of work. Like in doubles play, where Gilles began the season at No. 1,


