The resignation takes effect June 30. "I'm sorry she's leaving. I feel she did a fine job her first year as principal in the Clarenceville School District. But she obviously must return with him [her husband]," said Shibley.

SHIBLER said he planned to begin "immediately" to work toward filling the principalship with a board-approved replacement by June. ## Booklet available on jogging

Sell and Stransky point out that jogging improves the cardiovascular system, helps control weight and reduces anxiety.


