

Humble Returns To Area School

Harold R. Humble, a recent educator in India and a former principal of North Farmington High School, has been appointed the new administrative assistant in the Clarenceville School District.

Humble assumed his new duties Aug. 3. He succeeds L.V. Knowlton, who is recovering from major surgery and has been absent from the district since April 2. Knowlton will be assigned other duties at a later date.

Humble, in addition to assuming all current duties as administrative assistant, will represent the district as chief negotiator in all negotiations with the Clarenceville Education Association, custodial maintenance AFL-CIO Council 23, secretaries and bus drivers.

A resident of Farmington,

Humble recently returned with his family to Michigan after serving three years as the superintendent-principal of Kodaikanal school in South India. Kodaikanal is an American school accredited by the Middle States Association, offering a full program from kindergarten to grade 12.

Prior to the overseas assignment, Humble was principal of North Farmington High School

from its beginning in 1961 to 1967. His duties during that time included consultation regarding the construction and furnishing of the building as well as development of the education program.

He also served as assistant principal at Farmington High School from 1956 to 1961. From 1951-56 he taught mathematics and physical education at the junior and senior high levels at Farmington. He also was track and cross country coach as well as junior high basketball coach.

He has been active in North Central and professional associations. A native of Detroit, Humble earned a BS degree from Western Michigan University. He attended a summer session at the University of Southern California and earned an MA in secondary administration from the University of Michigan in 1955.

During World War II he served in both the U.S. Army and Air Force. As a school administrator in South India he was able to make educational visits to England, Italy, Ethiopia, Iran and areas of India.

He and his wife, Jane, have four children: Susan 13, John 16, Jeffrey 13, and Steven 12.

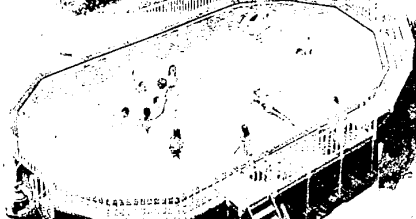
