Acting, singing, both are strong

Performances of the musical "Carousel," presented by the St. Bede Players, continue at 8 p.m. Friday-Saturday and 2 p.m. Sunday, May 19, at Mercy College in Detroit. For ticket information, call 537-7275 or 646-9413.

With competent acting and fine renditions of Rodgers and Hammerstein's wonderful music, the St. Bede Players production of "Carousel" rises above a slow-moving storyline full of the usual tropes common to daytime television and country-western ballads.

The musical unravels the tragic love story of Billy Bigelow, a hot-headed carnival barker who blows into town and falls in love with a home-town factory girl named Julie Jordan. They marry, which in 1873 was decidedly protocol among the good New England folk in the seaport town where the musical is set.
