Alcohol and drug use is a highly visible problem in today's society. To meet the need for formal, accredited educational programs in this field, Fairlane Health Services Corp. and Madonna College are making available to educators, counselors and other professionals who work with adolescents and young adults a Summer Institute on Chemical Dependency Studies.

Museum heads visit Detroit

The 80th annual meeting of the American Association of Museums (AAM) will be held June 9-13 at the Westin Hotel in the Renaissance Center. Expected are 2,000 museum professionals, trustees and volunteers from across the country, who will commemorate the centennial of the Detroit Institute of Arts and introduce members of the national museum community to Detroit's cultural institutions.

The theme of this year's meeting, "Museums For A New Century," coincides with the Detroit Institute of Arts centennial celebration. The goal of the meeting is to focus delegates' attention on preparing their institutions for the 21st century.

Highlights of the panel sessions will include: "Productive Board/Staff Relations: The Communication Factor," "Exhibition Design," and "Philosophies and Methods of Youth Museums." Dr. Arthur Jefferson, general superintendent of the Detroit Public Schools, will serve as commentator during a special session titled "Museums and Schools: Partners in Education."

The faculty will include recognized education, guidance and treatment professionals actively working with schools.

Lectures, case materials, discussions and experientially oriented learning labs will help participants form a working knowledge in the areas of chemical dependency in adolescents. Techniques of early recognition, community resources, and many additional aspects of drug dependency will be discussed.

The Summer Institute is scheduled from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday-Friday beginning June 24. Registration and tuition for the course is \$315. Three semester hours of credit or 4.0 CEU's will be awarded upon successful completion of the course.

To follow this Institute on Chemical Dependency is a three-day Advanced Institute on initiating student support groups in the school. It will be held July 2-4.

Topics to be covered will include children of alcoholics, group skills, affective, sobriety support and school intervention. Previous enrollment in the Chemical Dependency Institute or some other equivalent introductory course is required.

In the entertainment world, Russell has performed in major night clubs and hotels throughout the country.

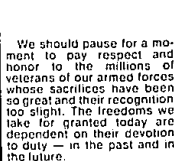
