Participants must be males who have had coronary bypass surgery or coronary angloplasty, and do not have any major diseases of other organ sys-

Henry Ford Hospital's Fairlane Cen-ter is seeking patients with high blood pressure to participate in a study to test a new drug. The study will evaluate the effective-ness of a new drug which may have fewer side effects than medications currently used to treat high blood pres-sure. The new drug is taken once every 24 hours, a major advantage over medication that now must be taken every three of four hours. Patients must be between the ages of 16 and 65, have high blood pressure (above 140/97, but not exceeding 115

diastolic) and obtain approval from their physician. Those not eligible to participate include women of child-bearing age; patients who have recent heart attacks or strokes; patients with chronic rashes or systemic diseases, such as lupus and asmatice sufferers.
