## Jerry Lewis telethon to be aired from Las Vegas

Jerry Lewis' Super Show, the telethon to benefit the Muscular Dystrophy Association (MDA), will be broadcast live for the fourth consecutive year from Caesar's Palace, Las Vegas.

This year's 21 hour extravaganza will air starting at 9 p.m. Sept. 1, announced Thomas Leahy, president of the Greater Southeastern Michigan Chapter of the association.

"The staff and facilities at Caesar's are phenomenal," said Lewis. "That's essential when you're producing a complicated show like ours that runs all day and all night, involving hundreds of celebrities. We're also hoping that last year's good luck is even better this year."

The 1984 telethon was the most successful televised fund-raiser in history, resulting in more than \$32 million in pledges.

The show for MDA is the association's most important annual fund-raiser event and, according to Leahy, its success has helped establish MDA as one of the world's leading voluntary health agencies fostering research and patient care.

MDA currently sponsors some 500 individual research projects conducted by scientists throughout the world. The association also supports 240 hospital-affiliated clinics nationwide where people with any of the 40 disorders covered by MDA program receive medical care, selected orthopedic aids and counseling.

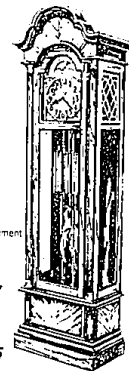

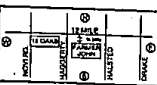

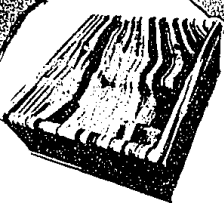
