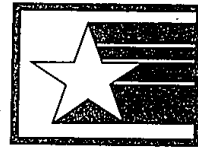

## Outdoor concerts: Sounds of summer

The eagerly awaited season of outdoor concerts has arrived, with most of the series underway in Detroit and suburban areas.

Two musically acclaimed couples are on a double bill Friday night at Meadow Brook Music Festival on the Oakland University campus near Rochester. Cleo Laine, high priestess of song, and her husband, jazz musician John Dankworth, plus singer Gayle Moran and her husband, jazz pianist Chick Corea, are the second attraction of the 22nd season.

Pop pianist composer Randy Newman performs Saturday night at Meadow Brook. Newman is perhaps best known for his satiric song hit "Short People," as well as "I Love L.A.," but there's another side to his musical nature. He has scored two movies, "The Natural" and "Ragtime." Not surprising when you consider he is a nephew of two great Hollywood composers, Alfred Newman and Lionel Newman.

Trumpeter Maynard Ferguson and his band return Monday night to P'Jazz at Detroit's Hotel Pontchartrain. Ferguson, who was once called the band-leader of the '50s, has a new band playing music from fusion and funk to mainstream.

New to P'Jazz is Special EFX (pronounced "Effects"), appearing Wednesday night. Guitarist-composer Chelli Minucci and percussionist-composer George Jinda call themselves "jazz rockers."

At Pine Knob Music Theatre in Clarkston, the varied concert lineup includes Howard Jones tonight (Thursday, June 20); Tom Petty and the Heartbreakers on Friday night; Hank Williams Jr. on Saturday night; and Jimmy Buffet and the Coral Reefer Band on Tuesday.

The Trinidad Tripoli Steel Band gives another concert on the "Summer Nights" series at the Troy Hilton on Friday. It's a Grand Prix Party, sponsored by radio station WCLB.
