Striking Faculty Forum members at Schoolcraft Community College have delayed the Scheduled opening of registration, classes and freshman orientation at least one week. Picketing instructors prevented the beginning of registration Monday, but Schoolcraft President Eric Bradner had announced cancellation and "indefinie" postponement the night before the cation after learning that the Forum voted Sunday night to "withhold services as of Monday, Aug. 34."

Larry VanderMolen, vice chairman of the Forum negoti-ating learn, told Observer Newspapers that 95 per cent of the Forum membership sup-ported the action. In addition to registration, classes were stated to begin Thursday of this week, and freshman night was scheduled for Thursday. Staff orientation was supposed to be held Mon-day and Tuesday of this week.


