River, Deadman said.
Farmington would foot 75 percent of
the improvement bill for the 10 Mile to
Grand River stretch, Deadman added.
"We would probably have to bond for
our share of the money, but we have
the capacity to do that," Deadman said.
The next time Oakland County is
"scheduled to receive federal funding is

in 1987, according to Deadman.

"If it (the revised road improvement plan) is approved and there's no right-of-way to be acquired, construction could begin late in 1988 or early in 1989". Deadman said, estimating the construction to last shout two years.

The last major road improvement to Orchard Lake Road was completed in November, 1980, when the road was

widened from two to five lanes from 12
Mile to Maple Road.
The project cost \$7.9 million, and
was the largest project undertaken by
the Oakland County Road Commission.
Farmington Hills contributed \$46,000
to the project and West Bloomfield
paid \$330,000 while the road commission chipped in \$486,000. Federal monles provided \$6 million for the project.
