

Zoo renovation job to Greenfield

Greenfield Construction Co. of Livonia was lowest of five bidders for \$11.9 million, in renovations at the Detroit Zoo in Royal Oak.

The renovations were made necessary by the construction of the adjoining I-696 (Reuther) freeway, state Transportation Director James Fitz said. The federal government will pay 90 percent of the cost and the state 10 percent.

Greenfield's bid was approved by the state Transportation Commission recently. Final approval is up to the state Administrative Board.

Work is scheduled to begin in October and be completed in spring of 1987. The work includes:

- A new three-level parking garage for 600 cars.
- A relocated entrance along Woodward Avenue.
- A 12-foot-high noise wall along the freeway at 10 Mile Road.
- A new security and administration building.

There also will be new concession stands, restrooms, ticket booths, platform for the zoo train, pedestrian bridge, storm and sanitary sewers.




