

Livonia Kennel Club Holds Show

The Livonia Kennel Club will hold its 25th all-breed dog show and obedience trial (un-benched) Sunday, Sept. 6, at the Detroit Race Course, Schoolcraft and Middlebelt. Show hours are from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

No member of the Livonia Kennel Club will exhibit a dog at this show.

A total of \$750 in cash awards and \$450 in trophy prizes will be

awarded. The best dog in show will receive a 15-inch tray, \$200 in cash and a rosette from the Livonia Kennel Club. First in each variety will be awarded a fluted bowl, \$25 in cash and a rosette from the club.

So far 90 German shepherders are entered, 41 doberman pinschers, and 40 poodles. German shepherders will be judged in an outside ring.

Art Afternoons Planned

Two "firsts" are programmed in the Detroit Institute of Arts' popular luncheon and gallery tour series. "Afternoon of Art," entering its seventh season each Tuesday and Wednesday from Oct. 20 through April 28, 1971.

A view of ancient art galleries now being strikingly redesigned will be one completely new tour, presentation and, secondly, this is the first year in which Founders Society members may attend with a minimum group of three friends on any "Afternoon of Art" day.

Originally the program was conceived to accommodate club and organization groups of 15 to 30 members and this remains its primary purpose. In a visual and verbal survey of prehistoric times through the great age of Rome, the ancient tour includes Celtic and Egyptian jewelry, Coptic textiles and Roman glass.

The other tour option takes groups through the Robert Hudson Tannahill Wing of American Art, exploring our nation's art from colonial times through the 20th century. It includes great American masters such as John Singleton Copley, Winslow Homer, Thomas Eakins, J.M.W. Whistler and John Sloan.

"Afternoon of Art" begins with luncheon served at 12:15

p.m. each Tuesday and Wednesday of the season (\$2.75 per person) in the museum's North Wing Court. Following luncheon, small groups are formed for the hour-long tour of their choice, guided by volunteer members of the Founders Society Decent Committee.
