'Blackwood Drake' Making Of A Band

"OK. Hit it on the downbeat. Punch the bom bom de da de da dum."

"Whoa, man! We never played it that fast in our lives!"

"Yeah. That's it. Right on. The sound is 'rock-beat' rhythm, and blues peppered with Rolling Stones, MC-5, Fleetwood Mac, Beebe King, Eddie Boyd and the late Otis Spann. The style is "Blackwood Drake."

THREE LIVONIANs, Terry Emery, Chris Marion and Wayne Burdette, la Garden City youth, Charlie Mahoian and Detroit Tom Martin, are the Blackwood Drake, one of a rising number in the make-it-or-break-it world of rock bands.

Theirs is the story of most young struggling groups bent on "making it" with their own unique sound, reminiscent in this stage of a little-known pop-pubbing group in Liverpool, England, about seven years ago, called the Beatles.

The sound may be reminiscent, but the location is a little changed. The group will next be playing at Plymouth's Fall Festival, Saturday, Sept. 12, between 9 and 10 p.m., in the Band Shell. By then Charlie will have returned from a trip to California, where he was invited to play with John Lee Hooker at Fillmore West.

The "Drake" actually began about four years ago with Mahoian, dynamic lead guitarist who claims frequent guest appearances with Hooker; Burdette, who says he plays what amount to "bassy" guitar; and Emery, a talented rhythm and blues pianist.

They had their share of spats, changes and regrouping before getting down to some serious music making in November 1969. Since that time, they've played to audiences in "almost every club in Detroit," plus the "Upstairs Ballroom" in Ohio; the "Elec-
