### Unemployment rises as summer jobs end

The end of summer jobs pushed Michigan's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate up to 10.9 percent in September, said Richard Simmons Ir., director of the Michigan Employment and tourism activities. Stimmons said 474,000 workers in the state were jobless ists most him p 19,000 from August. September's level is virtually unchanged from a year ago, when jobless rate was 11 percent with much of the increase.

"Much of the increase in unemploy-ment resulted from the loss of summer jobs as many of the state's recreational and tourism activities began closing down for the season," Simmons said.

Michigan's labor force increased a slight 9,000 to 4,351,000. Women re-entering the work force accounted for much of the increase.
