

Videotaping grabs spotlight

"In Camera Editing" allows completion at the end of an on-location shoot dealing with camera fades and pause controls.

The pause assures a clean edit because the camera backs up the videotape several frames in preparation. The pause deactivates at 60 seconds so videotape one scene, and put the camera on pause to change scenes.

Let's explore the mechanics of activating the camera with the theme "Color Tour of Memories." The video depicts a park scene with children chasing colored leaves, babbling brook, and pieces of bark and sticks.

Children run to the brook, kneel down and make sailboats of the leaves, then launch the boats and following them downstream.

• First write a sequence of events and think of it as your treasure map.

• Remember all props and equipment.

• Leave recorder on Audio 2 picking up natural sound. Cameras have microphones, but they're not always a dependable source. Wear the earphone to hear the videotaping.

• Balance whites and set appropriate light filters.

• Record color bars for 5-10 seconds.

• Activate fade for up to five seconds at beginning and end.

NOW WITH camera on Pause, set fade and activate camera establishing shot of the park scene. Pause the camera and zoom out for a long shot of children gathering leaves and running toward the brook.

Activate the camera and videotape the scene.

Pause before zooming in on the children creating boats and launching them into the water, then activate camera and videotape.

Pause and set up a scene with children following the boats downstream then set the camera to fade. Videotape the above.

STOP TAPING. Now rewind the tape and see your treasure through the viewfinder. You have completed your short subject video on "Color Tour of Memories." For more hints, call the Southwestern Oakland Cable Commission: 475-7286.

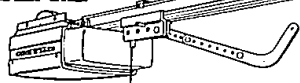

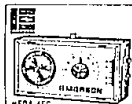
