

Kadish Attacks GOP On Taxes

State Senate candidate Paul Kadish, Livonia Democrat, says that election of his Republican opponent Carl Pursell will mean continuation of "the same type of unfair taxes which have resulted in local homeowners being socked with whopping annual increases in property taxes."

Kadish, speaking at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Martin Katz in Livonia, said that the

state constitutional provision which automatically permits the setting of higher assessments and higher property taxes was a product of the same type of Republican tax philosophy endorsed by his opponent.

Kadish said the question of who shall pay taxes and how much is an area of major difference between him and Pursell.

"My opponent supported the revised constitution with its soak-the-homeowner provision, says he favors property tax reduction but would replace the revenue by raising an already inequitable income tax."

"Whatever reliefs the average homeowner might get, he would more than lose with an increase in the flat rate income tax favored by my opponent. What I favor is relief for the moderate and middle-income family who is the forgotten person under my opponent's tax policy."

Kadish Supports S'Craft Faculty

Paul Kadish, Democratic candidate for 14th District state senator, joined the picket line of striking Schoolcraft Community College faculty Friday.

"If the administration is permitted to get away with these unreasonable demands at Schoolcraft College, it could be construed as a precedent at other schools, and who knows where this kind of thing will end," Kadish said in a statement.

"It seems the administration is asking the teachers to give up certain rights guaranteed by the U.S. Constitution — their right to participate in political activity."

"There is also a serious question of job security as under certain circumstances the administration insists that a faculty member may be fired without cause and without going through the grievance procedure," said Kadish.

"I support the faculty in their demand that the language of the new contract be, at a minimum, the same as it was last year."

"They are not asking for anything they did not have before and it is certainly reasonable for them to be unwilling to accept contract language that would take away their constitutional rights."

Kadish's appearance was announced in advance by Faculty Forum bargainer Larry VanderMolen.

New Health Plan Aids Poor

A proposed new federally-funded program of health care for poor persons has been approved by the Ways and Means Committee of the Wayne County Board of Commissioners.

The program would be operated by the out-patient department of Wayne County General Hospital under a three-year, \$1,497,302 grant available through the Michigan Association for Regional Medical Programs.

The Ways and Means Committee also recently approved two other grant applications — for \$1,043,000 in Federal air pollution control funds and for \$91,809 in State funds for a home artificial kidney training program.
