

350 Compete And Race In Old Car Festival

The 20th annual Old Car Festival, complete with 350 proud and shiny antique automobiles, ancient high wheel bicycles, fascinating special exhibits and a regime band bursts forth at Greenfield Village on Sept. 12 and 13.

A panorama of the history of America's early motoring days unfolds as 1920 cars show the mettle of both drivers and machines in series of races and contests. The "newer" cars, 1917-1925, go through their paces on Saturday while the old-

timers, 1898-1916, perform on Sunday.

Judged on the authenticity of their restoration, the blue-ribbon winners are eligible for the grand championship judging that climaxes each day. Since the Old Car Festival is recognized as one of the largest and finest events of its kind in the country, the awards are highly coveted.

For the first time this year the "Wheelmen," a national organization devoted to the restoration and riding of an-

tique high wheel bicycles are participating in the Old Car Festival. They will ride in the opening parade and give a special presentation of their skills.

Since bicycle manufacturers were among the first automobile makers and riders were very active in generating interest in the early cars, the Wheelmen represent an important part of America's automotive history.

Saturday will be Peter DePaolo Day at the festival. Greenfield Village and Henry

Ford Museum will honor DePaolo as the first man to break the 100-mph barrier at Indianapolis when he won the famous "500" in 1925. Known as two continents as "the golden boy of racing."

Throughout both days of the festival, five cars from the museum collections which help tell the story of that developing event will be displayed in the center of the activities field.

They are a 1906 Thomas Flyer and a 1911 Maxwell, forerunners of the current Chrysler

line, a 1937 Chrysler Airflow, the company's experiment in advanced, streamline design, a 1940 Chrysler Crown Imperial Phaeton, the official ticker tape parade car of the city of New York, and a 1964 Chrysler gas

turbine car. The turbine car is a recent donation to the museum from Chrysler.

Old Car Festival activities begin with a parade through the historic streets of Greenfield Village at noon and continue through the final Grand Championship judging at 5 p.m.

However, festival planners suggest that visitors come early and tour the collection of more than 200 antique cars on permanent display in the Henry Ford Museum before moving

into the Village to see the vehicles there bring America's early automotive days to life.
