ture in 1924 and operated it as an historic inn for 27 years. It was sold to the Anbut family after Clara's death in 1951.


The 150-year-old inn has a colorful history that has been carefully preserved by the Anbut family. Although there have been 13 additions to the original structure, it retains its rustic charm. 


