Try your hand at graphology

With the recent birthday of John Hancock, the first signer of the Declaration of Independence, I am reminded of the many times people ask me about signatures. So I thought this might be an appropriate time to discuss your John Hancock and offer some guidelines for analyzing it.

The signature, although revealing, should never be analyzed alone. By itself, it is not a reliable character indicator.

The signature delineates the manner in which the writer wishes the world to view him/her.

WHEN THE SIGNATURE and the text are quite similar in size and slant, harmony within the writer is suggested. Differences between signature and the body of the writing suggest some disharmony.

A clearly written signature without any additions or flourishes requires a certain moral courage; it shows the

real personality without any embellishment or concealment.

A signature more ostentatious by size or configuration than the writer's general script, implies the intention to impress others.

A small signature paired with a large body script indicates underestimating of self or possible modesty, depending on other things found in the

handwriting.

OFFICIAL AND PRIVATE signatures may vary widely. The diplomatic, secretive, shrewd or enigmatic personalities often project an illegible signature.

Optimism and ambition express themselves in an ascending signature.

The descending signature reflects a state of discouragement which may be due to fatigue, illness or depression.

Tallness in the first name can show confidence in self, but if over exaggerated can reveal self glorification. A person who feels he has exceeded his family in talent, abilities or accomplishment will often write his first name taller than the last name or use a much larger capital letter in his first name than in the last name.
