## ● CAR DAMAGED


Farmington Hills officers arrested two Southfield men after they allegedly tried to break into a car parked at the Gateway Apartments Monday night.

Arraigned Tuesday before District Judge Margaret Schaeffer of Farmington, were Thomas Gerald Moser, 20, and Russell Lloyd White, 19, stood mute to one count of breaking and entering of an automobile with damage and one count of possession of burglar's tools. Conviction could bring a penalty of up to five years in prison or a \$1,000 fine on the first charge and one year in prison on the second charge.

Both suspects were released on \$5,000 personal bond pending a preliminary examination in 47th District Court, Farmington.

According to police reports, the suspects were arrested at 12 Mile Road and Northwestern Highway after special patrol operations team (SPOT) officers saw one of them inside the car, a 1976 Datsun. Police found an AM/FM cassette stereo radio dangling from the dashboard inside the Datsun. Tools that police believe were used to try to loosen the radio were found in the suspects' car.

SPOT officers saw both suspects walk away from the Datsun. The officers also saw the suspects cruise several apartment complexes and residential areas before coming upon the Datsun. The suspects had been seen looking inside several cars and trying to open several car doors, Detective Craig Summers said.
