GOP reps hail Engler candidacy as 'exciting'

No one's endorsing her, but Republican state representatives from suburbia all say it's "exciting" that Colleen Engler is running for governor.

"She's everyone's second choice," said Rep. Mat Dunaskiss of Lake Orion, a Dan Murphy supporter.

The 33-year-old, fourth-term state representative from Mount Pleasant surprised party leaders when she announced she would be the fifth candidate — the only woman and tift the only displayed to seek the GOP nod Aug. 5 for a chance to take on Cov. James J. Blanchard.

A MORE cynical view in the Capitol press corps is that Engler faces a tough challenge for her college-town House scat and is using the gubernatorial race for media attention.

"We're really excited," said first-term Rep. Lyn Bankes of Livonia. She learned of Engler's decision at a monthly meeting of women legislators.
