group up in the cheese and spinach sauce. I ate the gournet shellfish slowly and with great enjoyment. Jambalyay rice with shrinp was a terrific value at \$7.55. The spices seemed het, but rather nice, although I did order a second leed tea. One can choose to order a wide assortment of lish-of-the-day, praced to order. Cajun, Mexican and Oriental variations provide an almost endless assortment of fish dishest to choose from. Luncheon service was excellent and the waitress seemed genuincly friendly and helpful with explanations of the menu items.


