

Met Star In Concert

Metropolitan Opera soprano Judith Raskin will lead off the parade of visiting artists to appear with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra this season.

The glamorous American singer will be featured in the symphony's program to be performed Thursday and Saturday, Sept. 24 and 26, at 8:30 p.m., in Ford Auditorium.

She'll be heard in Maurice Ravel's seldom-performed "Scherzade," which is a set of three poems for voice and orchestra, and in the final movement of the orchestra's principal offering on both evenings: Gustav Mahler's Symphony No. 4 in G major.

Sixteen Ehrlich will conduct and will open each performance with Hector Berlioz's "Corsair" Overture.

Miss Raskin's only previous appearance with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra was at the 1969 Meadowbrook Music Festival when the orchestra was led by guest conductor Andre Kostelanetz.

Priest-Composer Opens Christian Culture Series

Detroit's Christian Culture Series will have its 37th season opening Sunday, Oct. 4, in Ford Auditorium when it will present a concert by Father Clarence J. Rivers. Father Rivers is a singer, actor and composer, as well as a Catholic priest.

Called "An Evening with Father Rivers," it will be a joint lecture-concert-entertainment. The Orpheus Club of Detroit, augmented by women from the choir of Westminster Presbyterian Church of Detroit, will sing Father Rivers' "Mass Dedicated to the Brotherhood of Man." The program opens at 8:10 p.m.

There are 12 programs in all in the series. Sixteen Ehrlich will conduct the Detroit Symphony Orchestra in an all-symphonic program Oct. 18, in Cleary Auditorium, in Windsor.

AN EXPERT on space travel, Dr. I.M. Levitt, will discuss the topic "A Scientist Looks at UFO's" March 7 in the Veterans Memorial Bldg.

The final presentation of the Detroit Symphony will be under the baton of Pierre Hsu. Montreal-born Hsu will appear in Cleary Auditorium March 21.

Popular professor, prophet, critic and provocateur, Marshall McLuhan, will speak on "Exploring and Understanding the Challenges of this Electric Age" April 4 to wind up the series for the year.

The program is sponsored by the Detroit Audubon Society.




