

Here's how to host exchange students

You can bring a bit of France or Spain into your home by hosting a teenage exchange student for four weeks this summer.

The students are coming through the annual Nacel Cultural Exchange program to become part of an American family and to experience American-style living. Hosts are needed to welcome 200 French and Spanish teenagers who will be in Michigan July 1-28.

If this idea appeals to you, you should contact Evelyn and Julian Prince of West Bloomfield, the Michigan coordinators. The Princes first became interested in helping with the NACEL program as a direct result of hosting a French student in 1975 and have been coordinators, as well as participants, ever since.

"Hosting is a great way to brighten up your summer," Prince said.

"Besides bringing excitement to your doorstep, a European student is worth more than a dozen textbooks. While having fun, your family can learn firsthand about the country, language and culture of France or Spain."

Families don't have to speak French or Spanish to host, since the students have studied English for four to eight years and want to use the language while they are here. The parents supply their children with pocket money and pay for their transportation and insurances.

The program organizers carefully match these teen-agers with prospective host families according to shared interests and activities.

"Our plane this year is flying directly from Marseilles to Detroit Metro Airport," Prince said. "People from this southern part of France

and from Spain have the reputation for being relaxed, open and friendly. Hosting them should be lots of fun. Moreover, hosting is especially appropriate this summer when we are rededicating the Statue of Liberty, which is a gift from the French people and the symbol of welcome for Europeans coming here."

NACEL also offers a reciprocal program which gives American teenagers with at least two years of foreign language study the chance to spend four weeks during the summer with a European family. At present, there are openings for Session 2 to France (July 24 to Aug. 21) and for the German Homestay.

Nacel Cultural Exchanges is a non-profit organization listed with the National Association of Secondary Principals. NACEL is a participant in the President's International

Youth Exchange Initiative.

It is the largest exchange program between France and the United States and has growing programs with Spain and Germany. Nationally, 50,000 students and families have

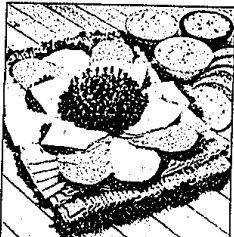
been served since 1969; locally, there have been 1,000 participants since 1980, when the Princes began organizing the program in Michigan.

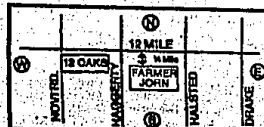

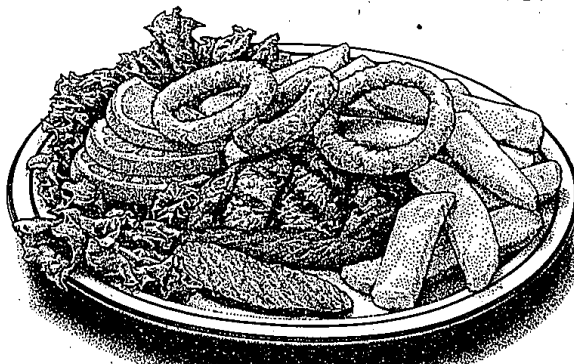

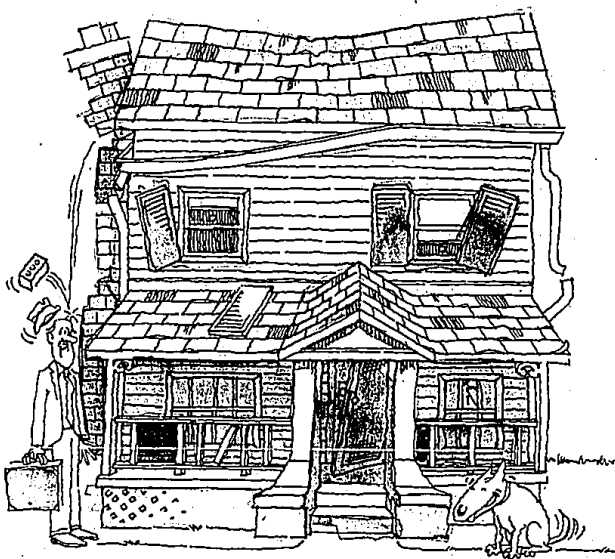
