Farmington Councilman Richard Tupper questioned concessions given by this year's Board of Review at the regular May 19 council meeting.

"The majority of concessions given were commercial," he said, as the council reviewed the annual assessor's report and Board of Review figures. City Manager Robert Deadman attributed the nearly tripled dollar concessions to this year's total increase of about five percent in assessed property values. Commercial properties are valued based on income potential for that year, Deadman said. "Concessions were higher than the preceeding year because assessed valuations went up. there
