GOING TO THE HOSPITAL

Physicians are asked by concerned children of an elderly parent: "Mother is hurting, she can't move, and she lives alone. Couldn't you put her in the hospital for a few days?" The physician usually releases their request.

Experience has shown that hospitalization for the elderly is to be avoided if at all possible. Problems that arise with such hospitalization include: confusion and delirium by the elderly patient, loss of strength because of the prolonged bed rest, profound constipation secondary to change in food and timing of meals, bed sores and blood clots because of the inactivity associated with hospitalization.

For the elderly patient with arthritis, the hours of sitting and lying in a hospital bed are potentially disastrous. While aging joints need rest, these joints also need activity. Receiving exercises in bed is no substitute for the range of motion that daily life offers.

Physicians appreciate the strain imposed on a family that needs to look after an ill parent living alone. However, as compared with hospitalization, home care is such a benefit to the elderly. It must be pursued to its fullest extent.
